Call for MOs to Partner WAGGGS in an Erasmus+ grant application related to European Jamboree 2020

Description and objectives of the activities

The activities described below have **three purposes**:

- *Deliver a high quality international educational experience to young people coming to European Jamboree 2020*
- *Provide a meaningful international learning experience to young volunteers, increasing their understanding of WAGGGS; the Girl Guiding and Girl Guiding Learning framework and educational Method, how it applies to young adults and teenagers 14-18 years old, practice leadership in a safe, supportive and international environment, enhance facilitation skills in a very diverse environment and build international friendship and Network*
- *Connect with decision and policy-makers and advocating for positive change*

Depending on how the MOs will address this opportunity, this can also be a **capacity building activity** for our Member Organisations. WAGGGS is keen in working with our MOs so they can benefit the most from it.

Background Information

Considering the request of the EJ2020 to WAGGGS and WOSM to contribute to the delivery of the Jamboree by facilitating workshops for 14.000 at the European village;

The ERW wants to continue giving **more opportunities to young European leaders to have a meaningful international experience, increase their feeling of belonging to WAGGGS as a wider movement, provide opportunities to practice their facilitation skills in a diverse international environment and practice leadership in a safe environment, having an impact on the life of thousands of young people in Europe, by connecting with decision and policy makers.**

With this opportunity, the ERW will offer educational activities to young people from all over Europe taking part in the different projects. To do so **we will recruit leaders with experience in working with this age group** to deliver educational activities at the central camp. WAGGGS facilitators at European Jamboree should be able *to deliver workshops in an engaging, fun and inclusive way, being aware of diversity issue at theoretical and practical level.* They should know the Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting Educational Methods and be able to apply it to the European Jamboree's age group, providing *Relevant, Accessible, Exciting and Learner-Led Activities* to participants.

If your MO is partner of the project, you **commit** to send participants to the 2 following activities:

- *Facilitator training for EJ2020, 5 days (activity 2)*
- *European Jamboree 2020 (activity 4) from the 27th of July to the 6th of August*

For activity 1, the process is managed by the JLS19 team – if you have participants going to JLS in a European hub you might benefit from a grant if you are partner of this project. **The grant might be subject to JLS participant facilitating sessions at the EJ2020**

For activities 3 and 5, we will be delighted to consider applications from volunteers of partner countries, but it is not a requirement to be partner.

Activities included in this Project

1. Juliette Low Seminar 2019 (JLS 2019):

The JLS is WAGGGS' flagship leadership development event for young people. This year, 2019, multiple JLS "hubs" will be hosted in every Region at the same time. Each JLS event will be an international, cross-cultural leadership development experience. In Europe Region, there will be 6 hubs with participants from all over the world!

They will be the pool of trained volunteers. EJ2020 is an amazing opportunity for them, as there will have the opportunity to deliver workshops related to every topics such as gender & diversity, active citizenship, SDGs, advocacy using the WAGGGS leadership model

European participants in European locations could practice the knowledge they gained and impact at a European level.

2. Facilitator Training for EJ2020

For having a better understanding on EJ2020, after their leadership training, the JLS experienced volunteers together with all the other volunteers selected, will attend a special 5-day training on [how to empower more young people and act themselves as facilitators in a big diverse European camp](#).

3. European Youth Event 2020 (EYE 2020)

Before EJ2020, participants selected will form one big WAGGGS delegation to participate at the European Youth Event (EYE2020). The event itself is [a unique opportunity for young Europeans to make their voices heard](#). Almost 9,000 participants come together for discussing ideas for the future of Europe with decision makers. This connection and cooperation will lead to have decision makers as guests in the EJ2020, where participants, during/after the WAGGGS workshops will be connected for advocating for positive change (for youth rights, gender equality etc.)!

4. Activities at European Jamboree 2020

From the 27th of July to the 6th of August 2020,

Every Scout and Guide possesses potential to become a driver of social change. They are all invited to come to the Jamboree and discover their power! Scouts and Guides will **inter-ACT** with others of various cultures, of various languages and various countries. They will learn through adventures, eye-opening discussions, and inspiring workshops. They will discover their power and find out where their helping hands are needed. Scouts and Guides will have a chance to **ACT** using their new skills and make a change in the society.

This project is a cross-cutting project and has many different learning paths and “empowerment zones”, to mention some of them: leadership, active citizenship, advocacy, governance, communication, peer-to-peer education etc. Starting for a small group of 20 people, this holistic program will reach more than 2000 people!
