THE WORLD THINKING DAY FUND

The 22nd of February, World Thinking Day (WTD), is a consistent annual highlight in the Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting calendar. Despite this World Thinking Day is experienced within the Movement throughout the whole year and is an opportunity to celebrate international friendship.

Since 1932 World Thinking Day has also been a chance to fundraise for the Global Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting Movement. Funds raised in celebration of World Thinking Day are used by the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts to provide programmes and opportunities for Girls and Young Women around the world.

Over the 90 years since World Thinking Day became a fundraising opportunity, the World Thinking Day fund remains as crucial as it ever was in supporting the Global Movement. However, since the COVID-19 pandemic, the fund has been greatly impacted and it continues to struggle.

In 2022, the World Thinking Day fund raised £64,050.46, an improvement on the funds raised in 2021. Despite this improvement, these funds raised still represent a significant decline compared the pre-pandemic fundraising totals.

Your support is needed for the WTD fund, now more than ever, so that WAGGGS can continue enabling Member Organisations and girls to feel part of the Movement which has given so many opportunities to so many people.

LEADERSHIP

Your gifts have made it possible for WAGGGS to increase its leadership offer to girls and young women globally, from the **Juliette Low Seminar** to the **Growing and Learning Framework** and the **Campfire** platform.



participants have impacted over 31,000 girls through their 100 girls projects throughout 2023.

The primary focus of a 100 Girls Project was to break down barriers to leadership for 100 girls, aged 12 to 18 years.

This year the WAGGGS volunteer network transitioned to Campfire; an online platform for the Movement.

This network is a diverse volunteer community with learning and development opportunities for all.

With your support WAGGGS has been able to work with 46 Member Organisations to look deeper into what makes quality Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting in today's context, and what is the appropriate role WAGGGS should play to support this across the Movement.

From this WAGGGS has been able to create the framework Growing and Learning, to support learning and development for both children and young people, and adult members, across the Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting journey.



WORLD CENTRES

The World Centres are hubs for international connection and activity. Each World Thinking Day they host activities from the activity pack in the centres. By completing the activities yourself and donating to the fund you are creating incredible international opportunities for girls and young women worldwide. The World Thinking Day Fund ensures these opportunities are available to as many as possible, regardless of their economic circumstances.



volunteers from 31 countries were able to work in the world centres as part of the volunteer leadership programme

The World Centres Volunteer leadership programme is a 3–6-month residential leadership experience for Girl Guides and Girl Scouts over 18 years old from all over the World. Based at one of the World Centres volunteers join a group of between 5 and 10 other volunteer leaders and can build their confidence, learn new skills, gain a greater understanding of the world and become an inspirational leader. In 2023, with the World Centres were able to host 64 volunteers, from 31 countries.













WORLD THINKING DAY 2023 PROGRAMME

World Thinking Day has always been a time for Girl Guides and Girl Scouts to connect with and celebrate our global movement. It s also an opportunity to explore issues that are important to girls and young women and positively influence our world

The theme for World Thinking Day 2023 was Our World, Our Peaceful Future. Following this theme, we focused on exploring topics of stewardship, harmony and the role the environment plays in peace and security.

The World Thinking Day 2023 activity pack, which has been downloaded over 39,500 times, focused on the story of Miku. Within the pack, World Thinking Day participants were invited to join Miku on her journey to find peace and balance in her world. Folktales from all five WAGGGS regions provided insipiration for Miku's story

The World Thinking Day 2023 activity pack was adapted to create a three part online activity pack. This digital resource enabled girls and young women to make use of technology for education and empowerment, while also forming and strengthening their connection with nature and the environment.

WALK THE WORLD CHALLENGE



The Walk the World challenge ran for exactly two months, starting on World Thinking Day 2023 (February 22nd) and concluding on Earth Day 2023 (April 22nd).

The challenge represented an opportunity for the WAGGGS Global Movement of 8.9 million Girl Guides and Girl Scouts to come together and take collective steps towards protecting our planet and a peaceful future while also celebrating World Thinking Day and raising vital money for the World Thinking Day fund.

Walk the World has been a great success as the Global Movement united took action for our peaceful future. The challenge saw 570 troops, units and individuals participate. In total, 66 countries were represented from all five WAGGGS Regions.

Incredibly, over 168 million total steps were taken as we collectively travelled around the world from The World Bureau in London, visiting all the WAGGGS World Centres and many crucial environmental checkpoints, eventually finishing back in London at Pax Lodge World Centre.

Walk the World participants have raised over £20,000 of vital funds for the World Thinking Day fund.
